21<sup>st</sup> December – School Closes for Christmas break at normal time.

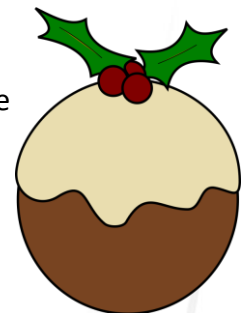

As parents know we try to encourage the children to think of others as we prepare for Christmas. This year we are asking for each child to donate one of the following items **each Friday throughout December**:

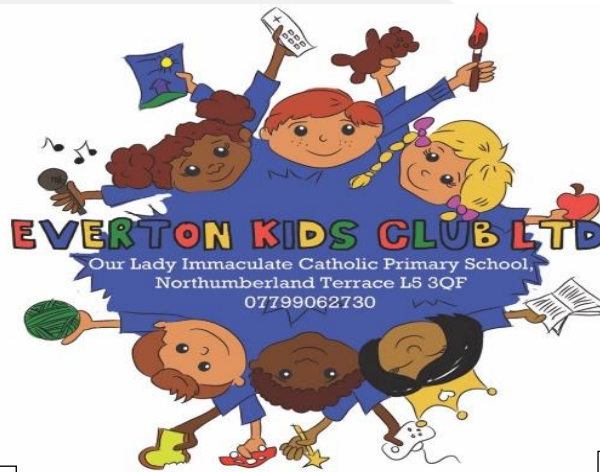
- A packet of chocolate biscuits,

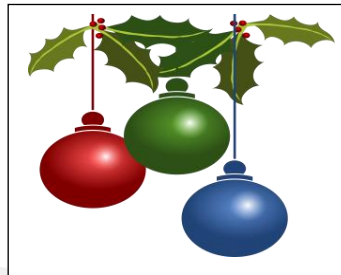
