<p>Children will be in groups (bubbles) and will not mix with other groups of children.</p> 	<p>School hours will be 8:50am - 3:20pm with different drop off and collection points (for now there will be no breakfast or afterschool club)</p> 	<p>For now, parents/ carers will not be fined for non attendance.</p> 
<p>Children will be dropped off and collected by one parent/ carer from different points around school</p>	<p>Children will not be able to wear gloves and face masks in school</p>	<p>We will continue to provide home learning to your child.</p> 
<p>There will be a daily clean of the school and contact points will be cleaned throughout the school day.</p> 	<p>Parents and carers will not be able to be on site; only to drop off and pick up at set points.</p>	<p>If you have a long journey on public transport, we would encourage you to stay home.</p>
<p>Children will be regularly reminded how to wash their hands effectively and there will be frequent hand washing.</p> 	<p>Social distancing will be in place where possible but it is not deemed necessary by the DFE if other actions are listed.</p> 	<p>Please inform school if your situation at home changes and you want to return to school (and you are eligible to do so)</p>
<p>Break and lunch times will be staggered and sections of the playground will be assigned to different groups</p>	<p>Water will be provided by school.</p> 	<p>School will continue to contact families learning at home to check in and support pupils</p>
<p>All meals will be provided by the school kitchen. Packed lunches will not be accepted onto the school site. The cost of a meal is £1 for packed lunch, £1.50 school meal. If you receive free school meals you will not have to pay the charge above.</p>	<p>Children will not be able to bring any personal or school items from home into school. This includes reading folders or PE bags or toys.</p>	<p>Please note: If your child is eligible to attend school, uniform rules will be more relaxed, the most important thing is fresh clothes each day.</p> <p>This is in line with the most recent guidance from the Government and DFE.</p>
<p>All children will have a pack of their own equipment.</p>	<p>If a child in your child's group has symptoms, every child in that group will be asked to self isolate for 14 days. And child or staff member with symptoms will need to be tested.</p> 	
<p>Toilets will be assigned to different groups</p>
