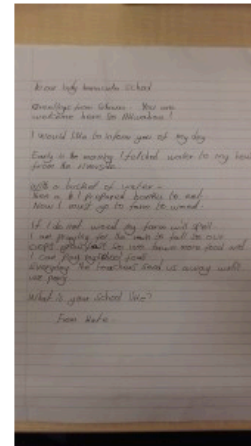
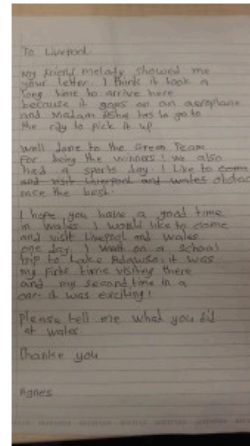
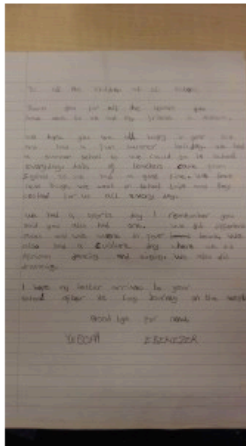


# OLI Lenten Focus 2017

# OLI Lenten Focus 2017

- It costs just £9 to send a child in Ankoma to school for a year. This means they can learn like we do so they can get jobs and earn money for their families.
- It costs only £4 per child to pay for health insurance so they can get medicine and treatment when they are sick or hurt.

# OLI Lenten Focus 2017

This year's focus...

- Each class will set a monetary target to help a certain number of children go to school and get health insurance.
- 

- If we raise £52 per class (about £2-£3 per pupil) this will pay for 4 children to get healthcare and go to school for a year.
- We have 12 classes in school – how many children can we help?

# So how will we raise the money ?

- Lenten giving is about doing small things to help others in big ways.
- We want to “do” things to raise the money... not just ask parents for it.
- Each class can decide what they are going to do to raise money.
