Can they wrap the cover up for you and reveal the title once you have finished reading it? What surprised you about their choice?</p>	<p>Predict what might happen. Use evidence from the text to explain your answer.</p>	<p>Become a show host. Create questions for a character. What do you want to know about their life/behaviour/thoughts/feelings? Tell them your opinion of them.</p>
