Ways to keep safe at Our School

Things we are putting in place to stay safe

Children will be in groups (bubbles) and will not mix with other groups of children.



Children will be dropped off and collected by one parent/ carer from different points around school

There will be a daily clean of the school and contact points will be cleaned throughout the school day.





Children will be regularly reminded how to wash their hands effectively and there will be frequent hand washing.

Break and lunch times will be staggered and sections of the playground will be assigned to different groups

All meals will be provided by the school kitchen. Packed lunches will not be accepted onto the school site. The cost of a meal is £1 for packed lunch, £1.50 school meal. If you receive free school meals you will not have to pay the charge above.

All children will have a pack of their own equipment.

Toilets will be assigned to different groups



Things to consider

School hours will be 8:50am - 3:20pm with different drop off and collection points (for now there will be no breakfast or afterschool club)

Children will not be able to wear gloves and face masks in school

Parents and carers will not be able to be on site; only to drop off and pick up at set points.

Social distancing will be in place where possible but it is not deemed necessary by the DFE if other actions are listed.



Water will be provided by school.

Children will not be able to bring any personal or school items from home into school. This includes reading folders or PE bags or toys.

If a child in your child's group has symptoms, every child in that group will be asked to self isolate for 14 days. And child or staff

member with symptoms will need to be tested.

What if I choose to keep my child at home

For now, parents/ carers will not be fined for non attendance.



We will continue to provide home learning to your child.



If you have a long journey on public transport, we would encourage you to stay home.

Please inform school if your situation at home changes and you want to return to school (and you are eligible to do so)

School will continue to contact families learning at home to check in and support pupils

Please note: If your child is eligible to attend school, uniform rules will be more relaxed, the most important thing is fresh clothes each day.

This is in line with the most recent guidance from the Government and DFE.
