Reading / mark making / Communication and Language Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Log into Rising Stars Login and access the books set by your teacher for daily reading. Login details: child's full name with a space between first and surname. Password: OLI123 and Centre Number: 6008942• Share the story Jack Frost talking about the story and your child's favourite part. Make a drawing of your favourite part and label it with the help of an adult sounding out each word e.g. j-a-ck f-r-o-s-t
Phase 1 phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Our phonics this week is to listen to environmental sounds. Watch this video and try to hear what each sound is environmental sounds• What environmental sounds can you hear during your winter walk? With the help of an adult, draw pictures/ write a list of what you sounds you could hear.
Physical Development.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Encourage your child to put on their own coat, wellies, hat, scarf and gloves to support their self help skills. Following the above activities go out for a winters walk, looking for signs of winter and Jack Frost! Take some photographs to use later when making a winter picture or collage.• Have a go at doing some Frozen themed yoga

<p>Maths.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play teddy bear counting Count the cakes using 1:1 counting correspondence and recognising numerals 0-5 then 0-10 • Watch Numberblocks and each day focus on a new number. Can you find that number around your house and in the environment? Can you count out that many objects around the house?
<p>Topic.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk about any new words throughout the story such as hibernation. Watch a video clip about animals that Hibernate in the UK. Draw and label some of the animals from the video clip. • Play the online game Dress the Teddy, dressing him suitably for winter. Make links to what we wear when going out for a winter walk. • Look at photographs taken during your winter walk and make a winter collage choosing cold colours such as white, silver, blue and purple. • Freeze some water asking your child to predict what will happen to the water when it goes in the freezer. How will it change? Compare the ice to ice seen during your winter walk (if it was cold enough!) How could you change the ice back to water? Place ice in different parts of the house and make predictions about which bowl of ice will melt first and why?
<p>RE - Come and See</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our topic this term is 'Celebrating'. We will discover what a celebration is and how people celebrate. • Read together, share and talk about: Cbeebies clips of celebrations around the world • Look at photographs or remember and to talk about celebrations they have been part of, other than birthday parties. What are their memories? • Draw a picture of how you celebrated Christmas. Talk about what happened with your family during Christmas and ask an adult to help you to label your drawing.
