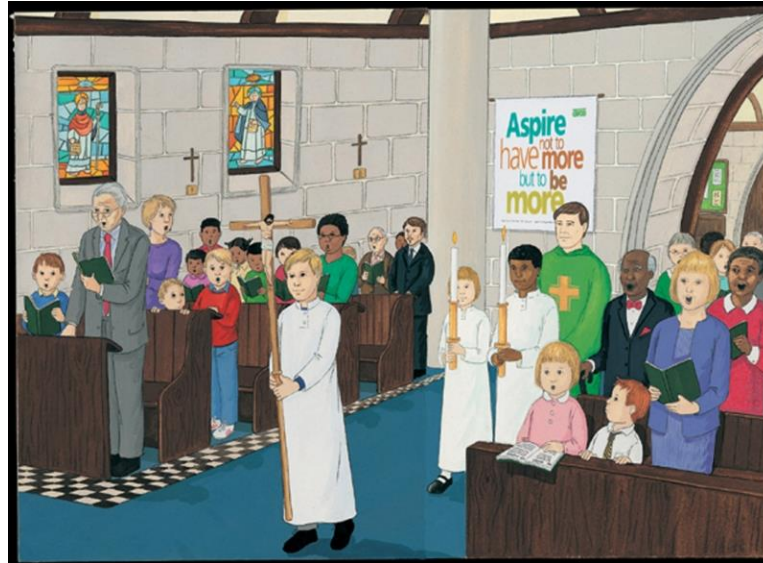

Reading / mark making/Communication and Language Development/ PSED	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Log into Rising Stars Login and access the books set by your teacher for daily reading. Login details: child's full name with a space between first and surname. Password: OLI123 and Centre Number: 6008942• Share the story How to Catch a Star by Oliver Jeffers. Following the story talk about what your wishes. This could be a nice way to get your child to talk about their feelings around the current situation and restrictions on seeing family and friends.• Cut out a star shape and support your child to draw and decorate their wish and place in the window Label their wish whilst breaking down each word into sounds (segmenting) then blending them together to read the word.• Learn a new song How Can I Catch a Star? inspired by our story focus. Can you hear the triangle? Can you clap along to the beat each time you hear it?
Phase 1 phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Our phonics this week is to continue to listen to and recognise Environmental sounds Watch this video and try to recognise what each sound is. An adult can help you to write a list of all the sounds you can hear whilst breaking down (segmenting) each word into smaller sounds then putting the back together to read the word (blending) e.g. d -o -g - dog• What environmental sounds can you hear at night? With the help of an adult, draw pictures/ write a list of what you sounds you could hear. Were they different to the ones you could hear during the day?

Physical Development.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wrap up warm remembering to put on your own hat, scarf, gloves and coat to develop your self help skills! Go outside for a walk during the early evening when you can see the stars in the sky. Talk about how you could catch a star like the little boy in our story focus. • Build a rocket at home using sheets and pegs. Pretend you're shooting up into space to catch your own star! • Travel to the moon in your rocket and have a go at doing some space themed yoga
Maths.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn to count forwards and backwards 0-10 with a rocket counting song • Visit the moon and learn to count with numberblocks. Can you count backwards from 10-0 in your rocket to blast off to the moon? • How many stars can you see in the sky?
Topic.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing Twinkle Twinkle little star and watch this short video clip to find out what a star is! • Following the above clip make a pretend telescope using a recycled tube and talk about the stars and moon as you look out of your window. • Draw or collage a picture of the night sky. What other things can you see from your bedroom window? You could add them to your picture.
RE - Come and See	<p><u>REVEAL: How the parish family celebrate.</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk about what a parish is? Talk about the church, the school and all the families you know at school and church. We all are part of a parish. Draw a picture of your own school family. • Talk about how we can celebrate in church. Have you have been to a Baptism, Christmas Mass, a Wedding? Look together at photographs of your baptism or of other celebrations in church and maybe draw a picture. • We are part of the parish (church) family. Sometimes the parish family celebrates in church, sometimes outside church. Talk about the picture below that shows us how the parish (church) family celebrates. Who are the people in the

pictures? What are they doing?
