Maths	Number Focus : 6
	Watch all the about the <u>number 6 on Numberblocks</u> .
	 Collect 6 objects around your house and count them using 1:1 correspondence. Make sure you touch each object as you say each number name.
	 Can you spilt the objects in different ways? Challenge: Can you write a number sentence?
	 Can you make a six sided shape using things you can find around the house e.g. sticks, string, ribbon, strips of paper etc.
Topic - Winter	 Go on a wintry walk and talk about what you can see, how did you feel, what do you have to do to keep warm? Learn more about <u>Antarctic</u> where it is very cold and snowy. Talk about the video with a grown up, what you think it is like to live here? What animals do you think live in the Antarctic? Talk or write about what you can see. Can you make a winter collage using things you can find around the house e.g. white paper, foil, cotton wool etc.
