Watch Mr Thorne's phonics videos to introduce the new sounds. Mr Thorne 'r' and Mr Thorne 'h'</p> <p>Can you be like Geraldine the Giraffe and find things beginning with these sounds? <p>Maths</p>	<p><u>Number Focus : 7</u> Watch all the about the Number 7 on Numberblocks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect 7 objects around your house and count them using 1:1 correspondence. Make sure you touch each object as you say each number name. • Can you spilt the objects in different ways? Challenge: Can you write a number sentence? • Can you make a 7 sided shape using things you can find around the house e.g. sticks, string, ribbon, strips of paper etc. • Make number cards on paper and put them in the correct order.
<p>Topic - Winter</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find out information about animals that live in the Arctic. Talk and write about an interesting fact that you have found out. Watch the video about Polar Bears and Narwhal. • Use yoghurt pots to make different shaped ice. You could also add paint or glitter to the water once frozen use the ice cubes to paint with. Follow this link to find out how to make ice cube paints. • Describe how the ice feels and talk about what happens to the ice when you hold it in your hand.
