Phonics	<p>Revisit & Review: Use the Phase 2 flashcards or join in with the jolly phonics songs and actions.</p> <p>Teach: The new sounds this week are 'b' and 'f'. Watch Mr Thorne's phonics videos to introduce the new sounds. Mr Thorne 'b' and Mr Thorne 'f'</p> <p>Can you be like Geraldine the Giraffe and find things beginning with these sounds? Can you practise writing any of the letters?</p> <p>Practise: Read the CVC words. <p>Maths</p>	<p><u>Number Focus : 7</u> Talk about the number 7 mat with a grown up. Can you think of any other ways to make the number 7?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go on a shape hunt around the house. Draw and name the shapes you have found. • Create a repeated pattern with 1,2 or 3 objects. We have included an example using fruit and veg skewers. • Count forwards and backwards to 7. • Play a counting game. 	
<p>Topic - Winter</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collect a copy of the book 'Lost and Found' from the school office. This will support your child's learning over the next few weeks. • Read and talk about your favourite part of the book. • Write a list of things the boy will need to pack for his journey. • During the boys journey he stops at Madagascar before arriving at the Antarctic. Compare both landscapes and talk about how are they different? • Make a travel poster for the south pole
