PSHE	<p>New topic all about Social media and E safety</p> <p>Explore the questions in this document about whether you feel the internet is good or bad.</p>
Come and See- Religious Education	<p>Talk to your child about books and how you use them. Discuss whether Kindle or electronic books would ever completely replace actual books. What makes a book a book? Is it possible to imagine a world without books? Talk about how books enrich our lives, whether they are electronic or hard copies, how they can take us beyond our environment and our own thoughts and ideas.</p> <p>Activity- Make a family photo album/book of events that you have done as a family during the Covid19 pandemic. Talk about the story of the year 2020-2021 and what a difference it has made to your lives.</p>
Pe and Sport	<p>Use running, jumping and throwing to play traffic lights with a family member. You need three items;1 red,1 orange and 1 green. When each colour is held up, you must perform the action for that colour for 1 minute. Aim to workout for about 20 minutes. You can add different coloured items to represent a different action.</p> <p>Red=stop Green=jump high Orange=jog</p> <p>Watch this video if you are unsure what to do.</p>
