Reading / mark making/Communication and Language Development/ PSED	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Log into Rising Stars Login and access the books set by your teacher for daily reading. Login details: child's full name with a space between first and surname. Password: OLI123 and Centre Number: 6008942• Share the story Laura's Star by Klaus Baumgart. Following the story talk how Laura wished she had a friend she could share her worries with. Talk to your child about how they are feeling with not seeing their friends in school.• Draw and collage a night sky with a star for each of their friends and together think of a nice message to write to their friends.• Take a photo of their collage and send it to the above school email for us to share on the website so all our friends can see the message.
Phase 1 phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Our phonics this week is to continue to sing a range of Nursery Rhymes starting with 'Twinkle Twinkle Little Star', linking to our story. Following each nursery rhyme think about the rhyming words and see if you can find any more e.g. star, are, far, jar, car etc• Play an online matching rhyme game on Phonics Play
Physical Development.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Join in with daily exercises to stay fit and healthy!• Wrap up warm remembering to put on your own hat, scarf, gloves and coat to develop your self help skills! Go outside for a walk during the early evening when you can see the stars in the sky. Sing Twinkle Twinkle Little Star.

Maths.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn to count forwards and backwards 0-10 with a rocket counting song • Visit the moon and learn to count with numberblocks. Can you count backwards from 10-0 in your rocket to blast off to the moon? • How many stars can you see in the sky?
Topic.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn about the planets through this fun song! • Use the above interactive planet song to draw and collage the solar system. Can you remember the names and the order from the sun? • Try this recipe for making star biscuits using only 4 ingredients!
