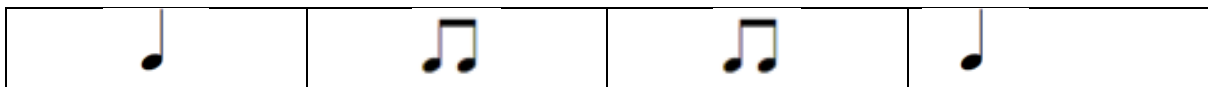


Year 6 Home Learning; Tudor Music

In class we are learning about Tudor music and trying to create our own music for a new king or queen. We are composing an ostinato or a repeating pattern for our percussion instruments (hand drums and tambourines). Could you use the boxes below to create your own 4 beat rhythms?
