	<p>What are the names of the three states of water? What happens to water at 0°C? What is peculiar about the solid form of water compared to the liquid? At what temperature does water boil?</p> <p>Activity: Can you produce a poster with labels and phrases detailing the importance and uses of water. This must include examples from the natural world, such as plants and animals; at least one industrial application; and various human uses, such as cooking, cleaning and recreational activities.</p> <p>The film showed a number of different ways that we use water, but we're sure you should be able to think of many more.</p> <div data-bbox="490 572 2069 920" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 10px; text-align: right;"> <p>Answers</p> <p>A transparent and colourless liquid. Solid ice, liquid water, gaseous water vapour (called steam when it occurs at 100°C or above). It freezes (or melts). Ice floats on liquid water, because its solid form is less dense than its liquid form: most solids are denser than their liquid forms. 100°C.</p> </div>
