On the next slide are three online messages. Do any of them set off alarm bells for you? Why?



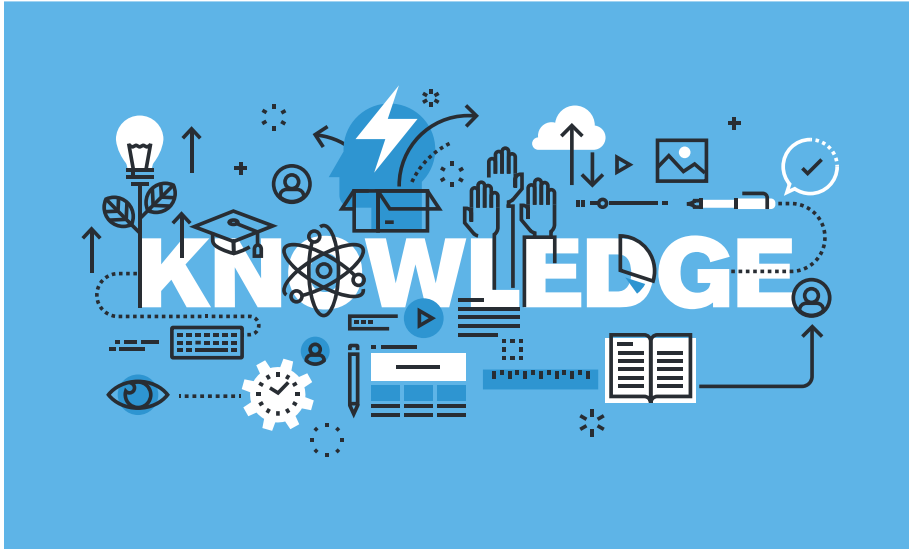
