Phonics	<p>This week we will be reviewing all the sounds we have learned and practicing reading simple words.</p> <p>Revisit & Review: Review all the sounds we have learned daily by using the Phase 2 flashcards. Can you use your flashcards or make your own to play 'snap' or 'pairs'? Each time you find a pair say something that begins with that sound.</p> <p>Practise: Can you write words to match the pictures using these phoneme frames . Print them or write them on paper.</p> <p>Play Picnic on Pluto and Phase 2 Tricky Word Trucks Login details: username: jan21 password: home</p> <p>Apply: Think of some simple words with these sounds in and write them.</p> <p>Challenge: Practice reading these Nonsense Words. Can you make up your own nonsense words and challenge someone else to read them?</p> <p>Alphablocks on Cbeebies is great resources to support reading</p>

Maths	<p><u>Number Focus :</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch Numberblocks 9 • This week we will be looking at different way to partition 9. Can you get two plates or bowls and split 9 objects in different ways. Can you write this as a number sentence eg. $6+3=9$ • Have a go at some of these number 9 learning challenges • Write numbers 1-10 on pieces of paper. Can you put them in order to make a number line? Which numbers come before and after 9? • Sing along with this Dinosaurs Counting Song on YouTube.
Topic	<p>We would love to hear about what you have been up to over the half term break. Can you draw and write about what you have been doing?</p> <p>We have been enjoying learning all about the different animals that live in Chester Zoo through their Virtual Zoo. Watch this video about their Penguins. Can you remember anything that you learned from the video?
