Reading	Log on to Rising Stars <u>Rising Stars Login</u> and access the book set by your teacher for daily reading. Read your favourite story books with your grown up and talk about your favourite part.
Phonics	Revisit & Review: Use the <u>Phase 2 flashcards</u> and this week's focus sounds in <u>Phase 3 Flashcards</u> or join in with the <u>jolly phonics</u> songs and actions. Teach: The new sounds this week are 'j', 'v' and 'w'. Watch Mr Thorne's phonics videos to introduce the new sounds <u>Mr</u> <u>Thorne 'j'</u> , <u>Mr Thorne 'w'</u> . Introduce a new sound each day and use the other 2 days to review the sounds. Practice reading and writing the exception words, 'we', 'me' and 'be'. Can you be like Geraldine the Giraffe and find things with these sounds in? Can you practise writing any of the letters? Practise: Practice reading these words <u>words to read</u> . Can you say each sound then blend them together? Play <u>Dragons Den</u> choosing our new sounds this week and <u>Phase 2 Tricky Word Trucks</u> Login details: username: jan21 password: home Apply: Think of some simple words with these captions by writing the sounds you can hear. Can you draw a picture to match each caption. Captions ; 'Jam on the mat', 'A red van' and 'Win a cat'

Can you get two plates or bowls and split 8 objects in different ways. Can you write this as a number sentence eg. 5+3=8? Can you think of any animals that have 8 legs? You could make a picture or craft of one of these animals.
