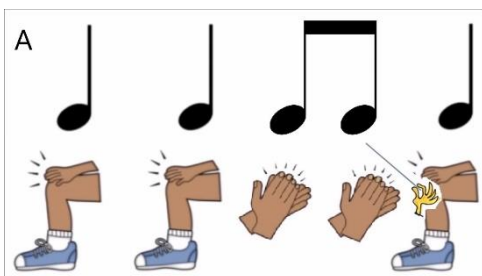


Hello Year Five,
