Science	This week we will be ending our topic on materials with a little experiment for you. This experiment will test your knowledge of the materials that are best to be used for absorbency. Could you pick 4 different types of paper (a piece of paper, a piece of card, a piece of cardboard and a piece of tissue paper) and predict which material would be more useful for absorbing (or cleaning up) a spillage of water (you can predict on post its, paper or verbally) Make sure you ask an adult to help you decide whether to use a small bowl of water (or any liquid) or whether you create the spill on the floor yourself. Then use each type of paper and investigate which material absorbs the water
