Recap the topic of unity and answer these key questions

- Why do you think friendships are important?
- What do you think is the most important value in friendship?
- How do you think your beliefs influence your friendships?
- What helps a friendship to flourish?
- What kinds of behaviour will break a friendship?
- Who is affected when a friendship is broken?
- What do you think is the best way to mend broken friendships?
- What kinds of activities have you been involved in which require more than one person?
- What have been the good aspects of that?
- Were there any difficulties? Why did that happen? How was the problem solved?

Activity- read the scripture and think about -why do you think Jesus prayed this prayer at this time?

- How do you think the disciples felt when they heard this?
- How do you think it might have affected their beliefs and their behaviour to one another?
- Which are your favourite words and phrases and why?
- Are there words or phrases which make you stop and think?
- What can you learn from this?
