Spelling	This week we will be continuing work on suffixes. Our focus will be using er and es at the end of words. Your activities will be uploaded to Seesaw each day for you to complete.			
Maths	This week we will be reviewing our knowledge of Times Tables. Please see Seesaw for your activities each day.			
Come and See	This week we are learning about the stations of the cross which show the last events in Jesus' life.

Geography	You will be exploring all of the different Easter traditions that happen around the world with an informative ppt. You can then complete your own Easter Tradition activity on the template provided. Please see your Seesaw account for this.			
PE	We have been focusing on indoor athletics, including running and jumping activities. It would be great to see a picture or video of you in your garden completing one of the following with your family- Relay races (passing a baton or item you have at home to use) Sprinting races - who is faster, you or your sibling? You or your parent/carer? Use small items to create an obstacle course to practise your jumping skills. Remember that a leap can be used for jumping longer or higher and a hop can be used for jumping a small distance.
