

REOPENING OF OUR SCHOOL – 8TH MARCH 2021

On Monday 8th March school is reopening for all children.

We have reviewed the timings of the day so that we can reduce congestion at the school gates and safely stagger our family groups and classes as they enter and leave school.

Siblings/families will now be grouped together according to the oldest sibling. The family will still arrive and leave together according to the oldest child's year group. **Please note the timings of the day for your child/family group may have changed.** They will leave and enter school from their allocated gate.

Other information for parents

Children should come to school in their PE kit on their class PE day.

Children should bring their reading folder to school each day. To reduce infection children must not bring personal belongings into school.

All children will receive a school dinner/school packed lunch.

For those families who do not receive Free School Meals can I remind you that the weekly cost of a school lunch is £6.50. The cost of this has been greatly subsidised by the school.

In order to reduce the risk of infection we have been advised that **we are unable to accept cash in school**. Parents can make an electronic payment at school using our card reader or through SIMSPAY (previously known as AGORA).
