## Ways to keep safe at OLI

Children will be in groups (bubbles) and will not mix with other groups of children.



School will be operating by staggered starts and at the end of the school day.

Breakfast club is available from 8am.



All children are now expected to be in school and parents may be fined for non-attendance.

Children will be dropped off and collected by one parent/ carer from different points around school

Children will not be able to wear gloves and face masks in school

Home learning will continue for any children who have to self isolate if their bubble is sent home.

There will be a daily clean of the school and contact points will be cleaned throughout the school day.



Parents and carers will not be able to be on site; only to drop off and pick up at set points.

Social distancing will be in place where possible but it is not deemed necessary by the DFE if other actions are listed.

Children will be regularly reminded how to wash their hands effectively and there will be frequent hand washing.



Full PE kit is to be worn to school on days when physical education is taught. Children will NOT be permitted to wear football kits.

Break and lunch times will be staggered and sections of the playground will be assigned to different groups

Water will be provided by school.



Reading is a major priority for the children this term. **Reading folders should be brought to school everyday.**

All meals will be provided by the school kitchen. Packed lunches will not be accepted onto the school site. The cost of a meal is £1.30, this has been subsidised by the school in order to support parents and will be reviewed during the Autumn term.

Children will not be able to bring any personal items from home into school.

If a member of your child's bubble tests positive for Covid 19 every child within that bubble will be asked to self isolate for 10 days. Any child or staff member with symptoms will need to be tested.



Children are expected to be in full school uniform, ties are available from school and a cashless system is in place. Please use a debit card or SIMS pay if possible to pay for school meals.

All children will have a pack of their own equipment.

Toilets will be assigned to different groups
