Reading / mark making/Communication and Language Development/ PSED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Log into <a href="#">Rising Stars Login</a> and access the books set by your teacher for daily reading. <b>Login details:</b> child's full name with a space between first and surname. <b>Password:</b> OLI123 and <b>Centre Number:</b> 6008942</li><li>• Practise writing your name, holding the pencil in a <a href="#">tripod grip</a>. Watch this short video to help you!</li><li>• Share the story <a href="#">Pirates Love Underpants</a> and talk about which part of the story you liked best and why? Talk together about how the pirates took the treasure from the other pirate crew. Was this a nice thing to do? What could they have done differently? Talk about the importance of sharing.</li></ul>
Phase 1 & 2 phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Listen to <a href="#">Jolly Songs</a> and join in with the actions to learn the sound of each letter of the alphabet!</li><li>• Play 'I Spy' hearing and saying the sound at the beginning of objects you can see.</li><li>• Practise <a href="#">blending sounds</a> in simple words to read.</li><li>• Play <a href="#">Balloon Phonics game</a> and see how many words you can read!</li></ul>

Physical Development.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use props at home to build a pirate ship using pegs and materials to make a sail, strengthening muscles in your hands.</li> <li>• Join in with some <a href="#">pirate yoga</a></li> <li>• Learn a new <a href="#">pirate dance</a></li> </ul>
Maths.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learn to count with <a href="#">Patch the Pirate</a></li> <li>• See how many targets can you hit in this <a href="#">pirate counting game</a></li> <li>• Share the story <a href="#">10 Little Pirates</a>. Can you show that many pirates on your finger each time?</li> <li>• Draw 10 little pirates writing the number above each pirate's head.</li> </ul>
Topic.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learn a new <a href="#">Pirate song</a> and practise moving your body forwards, backwards, up and down!</li> <li>• Draw a picture of your family and hide it somewhere in your house or garden. Make a treasure map for someone in your house to follow and find the hidden 'treasure'. Remember x marks the spot!</li> <li>• Use empty cartons or boxes to make your own pirate ship. You could try using different material and see if any of them float in the bath!</li> </ul>
RE - Come and See	<p><b>Our RE topic is Our World</b></p> <p><b>Reveal: God created the world and said 'Indeed, it is very good'</b></p> <p>Talk about all the lovely things we have in our world - the grass, flowers, trees, sky, sea, sun, moon, stars, animals etc. Tell children how God made our world in 7 days. Draw or paint a picture of our beautiful world. Watch this short video and discuss ways in which we can look after <a href="#">our World</a></p>
