Reading	Log on to Rising Stars Rising Stars Login and access the book set by your teacher for daily reading. Read your favourite story books with your grown up and talk about your favourite part.
Phonics	<p>This week we will be reviewing all the sounds we have learned and practicing reading simple words.</p> <p>Revisit & Review: Review all the sounds we have learned daily by singing the jolly phonics songs for both the phase 2 and phase 3 sounds. Practise singing the tricky word song.</p> <p>Practise: Can you write some simple cvc words with the sounds you have learnt so far?</p> <p>Play Buried Treasure</p> <p>Apply: Think of some simple words with these sounds in and write them.</p> <p>Challenge: Use your phonic knowledge to write a simple sentence.</p> <p>Alphablocks on Cbeebies is great resources to support reading</p>

Maths	<p><u>Number Focus :</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch Numberblocks- teen numbers • Can you make the teen numbers using things you can find around you house. • Add two numbers up to 10 together. What number does it make? Can you write it in a number sentence? • Write numbers 1-20 on pieces of paper. Can you put them in order to make a number line? Which numbers come before and after 15?
Topic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write a letter to the teachers in year one. Things you could include in your letter: your favourite book, who you like to play with and who you like with. The teachers in year one will love reading all your letters. Don't forget to email them into us. • This term we have been thinking of the lovely things you do together as a family during the summer holiday. Draw and write about what you are looking forward to do during the holidays.

RE	<p>Our RE topic is Our World</p> <p>Reveal: God created the world and said 'Indeed, it is very good'</p> <p>Talk about all the lovely things we have in our world - the grass, flowers, trees, sky, sea, sun, moon, stars, animals etc. Tell children how God made our world in 7 days. Draw or paint a picture of our beautiful world. Watch this short video and discuss ways in which we can look after our World</p>
