Children should continue to be dropped off and collected from their key stage entrance.

Years 1 and 2—Park Entrance Years 3 to 6—Main Gate

#### School hours will be:

8:45am—3:15pm for Years 1-6

### At the end of the school day

Classes will line up and be dismissed to parents a class at a time from their key stage gate.

The **Nursery Gate** will be open at:


- ♦ 11.15am—end of AM session

All meals will be provided by the school kitchen.

Children can choose either a school hot meal or a school packed lunch.

#### Meal cost is £1.30.

For children in Reception and KS1 this meal is free



We will continue to carry out a midday clean of high traffic contact points.



Children's break and lunch times will be staggered as this has worked well

Water is provided by school daily.

Children can bring water bottles from home to be filled on the premises with fresh cold water if they wish.



Children are expected to be in full school uniform.



Ties can be bought from school (£3) and a cashless system is in place.

Please use a debit card or Pay 360 (simspay) for all school transactions including meals.





Full PE Kit should be worn to school by your child on days when PE is taught. Children will not be permitted to wear football kits.



Reading is a major priority for the children and reading folders should be brought to school every day.
