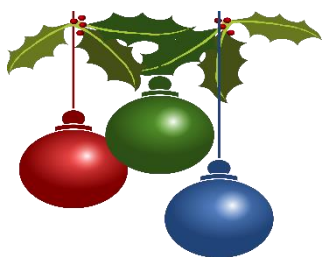
Staffing News
