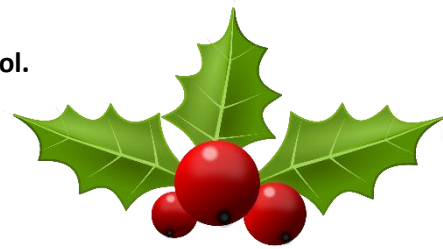
December 2021- Christmas activities in school
