Nursery are enjoying taking part in weekly PE lessons with Miss Molloy and Miss Campbell. They have been developing listening and spatial awareness skills to support them in PE.



We have enjoyed beginning our Come and See topic of 'Growing' which started by making our Lenten promises. We would also suggest that as a family that you take part in Lenten giving, where possible, to those less fortunate in the form of a small Food Bank donation or simply checking in with an elderly neighbour or relative.
