About Seedlings

Seedlings is a therapy service for Liverpool's primary schools.

If you feel a Primary school aged child may need to speak to a Seedlings therapist in school, we recommend in the first instance speak to the school's mental health lead to find out if a child's school accesses the Seedlings service.

If your school does not have a Seedlings service you can refer a child to be seen in a YPAS community hub by contacting clinical admin on 0151 707 1025.

How will this service help me?

The Seedlings team support the emotional needs of children allowing them to develop, grow and to build their resilience. Difficult feelings can affect relationships with important people in our lives, when these feelings are expressed in therapy it becomes easier to understand and make sense of.

Our Team

Our qualified & registered therapists provide a range of creative therapies that is age appropriate using a child centered approach.

This may include:

- Talking therapies
- Arts therapies
- Dance & Movement therapies
- Orama therapy
- Support and advice for families & school staff

Why are children referred to this service?

Children could be referred to Seedlings for a whole range of reasons, including a lack of confidence in their school work, peer relationships and difficulties at home. Sessions with a therapist can allow them some dedicated space and time to explore their feelings.
