Two Year Old Curriculum Information

Welcome to all the children in the Two Year Room. On our first week we had 100% attendance which is fantastic.

KEEP UP THE GREAT WORK!

Our book focus this term is 'Mouse Paint' by Ellen Stoll Walsh. We will be exploring what happens to the different colours when we mix them together.

We have also been learning and singing lots of traditional nursery rhymes and songs during circle times.

After half term our book focus will be 'Peace at Last' by Jill Murphy.

We have started our Come and See topic Creation and Covenant. During this topic we will be exploring how God made our beautiful world and everything in it.

The children have been joining in with collective worship by learning the actions and words for our school prayers.

Over the coming weeks we will be learning hymns and Christmas Carols.

We will be focusing on Phase 1 phonics where we will be developing our listening and attention skills. We will be focusing on the correct pronunciation of letter sounds.

This is a vital skill which will support children as they learn to read.
