Reception Curriculum Information

This term your child's PE session will be on **Monday** please send your child into school wearing their PE kit.

Our book focus this term is 'The Something' by Rebecca Cobb. We will be learning facts about nocturnal animals and will look forward in welcoming our nocturnal visitors on the 25th October.

After half term our book focus will be 'Star in Jar' by Sam Hay.

During maths we will be exploring numerals up to 5 and looking at the composition of numbers up to 5.

Our RE topics for this term are:

- **Creation and Covenant:** During this topic we will be exploring how God made our beautiful world and everything in it.
- **Prophecy and Promise:** We will be listening to the story of how Mary travelled to Bethlehem to give birth to baby Jesus.

We will continue sending home the phonics that we have covered during the week. It is really important that you encourage your child to practise reading the words and sentences .
