Year 1 Curriculum Information

PE /Sports news

Miss Whittaker's class are enjoying teacher led sessions focusing on ball skills this term and Mrs Bradley's class are working hard with the Rugby Tots coaches. Both classes are focusing highly on their listening and attention skills when working as part of a team.

Please ensure your child has a full PE kit including trainers or pumps, in order to take part in the session.

Homework support

SeeSaw will be our main form of homework communication with tasks to complete each week (set on Friday) related to a range of curriculum subjects.

Homework consolidates and revisits learning from school and is a great opportunity to talk to your child about what they have been learning.

Curriculum focus

In Literacy the books will be using as our vehicle texts this term are-Major Glad, Major Dizzy and Rapunzel and will support the children in writing a narratives and instructions.

In Maths we will be exploring numbers to 20 in a variety of ways and be able to talk about numbers using a wide range of vocabulary such as- More, less, fewer, equal too, subtract, add, calculate

Phonics is taught daily and the children will be working through the Little Wandle Phonics scheme to revisit Phase 3 and then begin to learn new representations of sounds they have already been taught in Phase 5.

In science we will be exploring materials and how we use them in our daily life. Children will be able to distinguish between an object and the material it is made from.

Packed lunches

Can we please remind you that your child is still entitled to a free school meal this year and have a great variety to chose from.

If your child does have a packed lunch then you need to ensure it has a range of healthy foods that can include-

A starchy food like a sandwich, wrap or pasta, a dairy food or dairy replacement (yoghurt/cheese), a piece of fruit and a small treat. We do not allow fizzy drinks as part of a healthy packed lunch in school.

Reading books will be changed every Thursday.

Please remember to sign your child's reading record every night so we know they have read and how they are progressing at home.

Remember to send in a water bottle each day with your child.
