Dear Parents and Carers,

We want to update you on the actions the school has taken to address ongoing concerns about parking and enforcement around our site. We fully appreciate the challenges faced by families, especially during busy times such as drop-off, pick-up, and school events.

Actions Taken by the School:

- We have contacted local councillors and Highways Officers to raise concerns about the current enforcement measures, which we believe are causing difficulties for families, staff and visitors.
- Emails have been sent requesting a review of these enforcement actions and asking for a more balanced approach that prioritises pupil safety without penalising parents and staff unnecessarily.
- Representatives from the Archdiocese have visited the school to support our efforts.
- Kim Johnson MP will be visiting the school to hear our concerns and advocate for improvements.
- The Director of Children's Services for Liverpool will also visit to review the impact on pupil safety and community wellbeing.

Despite these interventions, enforcement remains in place for now, and we have not been given assurances that this will change before the Christmas period.

Christmas Performances will go ahead as planned, and we are very excited to welcome you to celebrate this special time with us. However, due to the ongoing enforcement and parking restrictions, we strongly encourage parents and carers to:

- Walk to school where possible
- Car share with other families

Please note that if you choose to park on surrounding roads, this will be at your own risk, as parking enforcement may occur.

We appreciate your understanding and co-operation in helping us keep our children safe.

We will continue to challenge these measures and will keep you updated.
